kurimanzutto presents the most recent project by Gabriel Sierra (Colombia, 1975): *Museum Hours* is the reconstruction of a small collective exhibition organized in the early 1970s by a group of unknown artists. All the works presented could be situated within the canon of Western modernism, whilst also strongly resonating with conceptual art and the current global political situation. The pieces in this project share the same dilemma: how to represent or interpret ideas from a dream world. *Museum Hours* also takes cues from writings produced by Sierra in his personal dream journal, as well as on situations and characters from a novel yet to be published by the artist.

about the artist

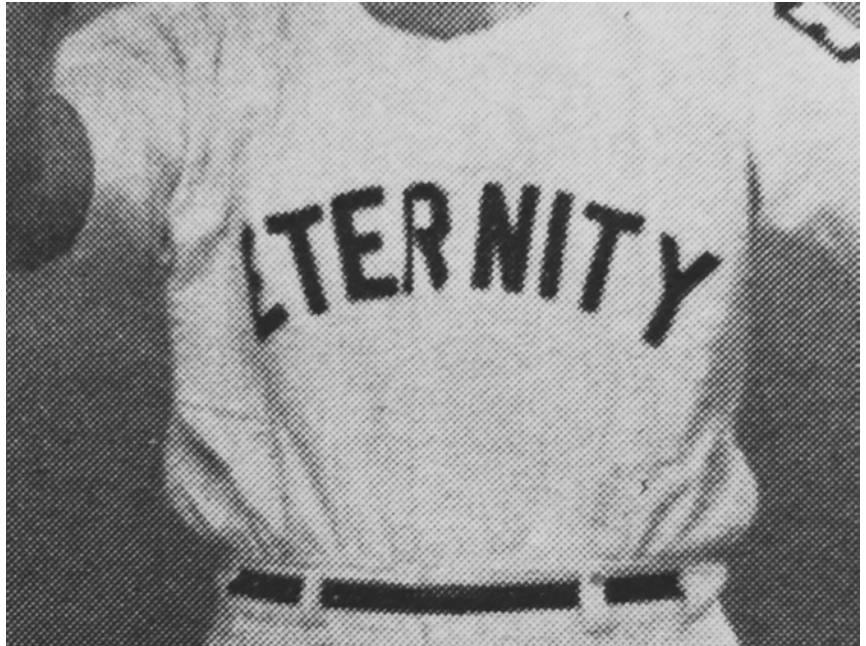
Gabriel Sierra received a degree in Industrial Design from the Universidad de Bogotá Jorge Tadeo Lozano in 1999. He has been an artist in residence at the KADIST in San Francisco (2012), Gasworks in London (2009), and CAC Brétigny in France (2006).
