Ilana Savdie Ectopia 31 May – 27 July 2024 White Cube Paris

White Cube Paris is pleased to present Ilana Savdie's (b. 1986, raised in Barranquilla, Colombia and Miami, Florida) first solo exhibition in France, featuring new paintings and works on paper.

Based in Brooklyn, New York, Savdie's work has been deeply influenced by the Colombian tradition of Carnaval. She sees the queer potential in the Carnivalesque idea that figures and characters can change at any moment.

The artist draws from a range of subjects and environments as source material, creating finely detailed, vibrant paintings in acrylic, oil and beeswax, which meditate on corporeal and metaphysical excess. The concept of performance as a transformative process, and themes of transgression, identity and power also often appear in her work.

Ilana Savdie's exhibition at White Cube Paris follows her solo exhibition 'Radical Contractions' at the Whitney Museum of American Art, New York in 2023, and 'In jest' at White Cube Bermondsey in 2022. Her work is held in museum collections around the world including Hammer Museum, Los Angeles; Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, Washington DC; The Jewish Museum, New York; Museum of Fine Arts, Boston; National Gallery of Victoria, Australia; Pond Society, Shanghai; and Whitney Museum of American Art, New York.
