Kerlin Gallery is pleased to present *November 2026*, an exhibition of new painting by Maureen Gallace

Kerlin Gallery are delighted to present a new series of paintings by American artist Maureen Gallace, the artist's first exhibition with the gallery in over 20 years.

Gallace is widely recognised for her luminous portrayals of coastal and rural environments in the American Northeast. Working at an intimate small scale, she paints uninhabited houses, shorelines, and quiet landscapes. The images, often transformed through memory, present a visual language that balances observation and abstraction. Gallace works with oil on panel, using a wet-on-wet technique to create simplified perspectives whilst retaining expressive brushwork. By stripping away extraneous detail, she creates images that suggest a sense of universality and timelessness.

Gallace's palette shifts from the soft glow of summer to the stark light of winter, inviting viewers into the work. Her scenes feel both specific and elusive, suggesting places shaped as much by memory and perception as by direct experience.
