Petzel Gallery is pleased to announce a solo exhibition by Mexico-based artist Jorge Pardo. This is his eighth exhibition with the gallery.

The crux of this exhibition is a spare bedroom that measures 12 feet high, 14 feet wide, and 26 feet long with two points of access. Constructed of steel and ornately cut wood, the interior consists of carpeting, tiles, a lamp, textiles, all designed by the artist. A space of leisure as much as a haven, the bedroom exists to be used as a point of rest, or one may choose to walk through looking both in and out of the room simultaneously. Surrounding the bedroom will be several wall sculptures inspired by South Native American masks. These masks have never been exhibited in the United States before. A collection of twenty-five colorful glass lamps will overtake the ceiling of part of the gallery.
